

# NAU Senior Legacy Scholarship

## Criteria

- a) Full-time undergraduate student enrolled at Northern Arizona University;
- b) Entering senior next fall semester (90+ credits);
- c) Minimum grade point average of 2.75 [where A = 4.0];
- d) Demonstrate financial need;
- e) Student must complete application packet, which includes:
  - i. Two letters of recommendation: one from a faculty member or academic advisor; and one from a supervisor, leader, coach or group advisor from the student's on campus participation area;
  - ii. Listing of on-campus involvement and activities including the names of supervisors, leaders, coaches, or advisors for each activity/group. If the student is the leader or founder of the activity/group, then the contact information of an advisee must be supplied. On campus activities may include employment, participation in and positions held in student groups and organizations, athletics, etc.; and
  - iii. 250-500 essay words on the following topic: How would you describe your legacy at NAU? What have you given to NAU and how will this scholarship help you achieve your goals?

# How to Apply

- ✓ First, you must fill out the main scholarship application (called STARS) on the Financial Aid webpage: <a href="http://nau.edu/FinAid/Scholarships/">http://nau.edu/FinAid/Scholarships/</a>
- ✓ Once you have completed that, a list of scholarships you are eligible to apply for are visible to you.
- ✓ Click on the link to the NAU Senior Legacy Scholarship.
- ✓ Fill out all appropriate information and submit the required documents listed in the criteria box above.

Incomplete application packets <u>will not</u> be considered, so please make sure to complete all information and submit all required documents!
