PROGRAM INFORMATION

You may use individualized coursework (up to 6 units in PSY 485, 497, PSY466 or PSY408) toward your Psychology Degree with the following conditions. You must obtain prior written approval from your Psychology faculty advisor and the Psychology Department. You must use only individualized coursework with a PSY prefix. You may take no more than 6 units of PSY485 or PSY497. Individualized coursework includes the following: PSY408 (Field Work 1-12 units maximum), PSY485 (Undergraduate Research 1-6 units maximum), PSY497 (Independent Study 1-6 units maximum) and PSY466 (Legislative Internship 1-12 units maximum). Additional units of PSY466 and PSY408 may be used to fulfill general electives.

A grade of C or better is required in all Psychology coursework (36 units) to earn your degree in Psychology. **Of the 36 units required for this major, 15 units must be upper-division courses.** In addition, you may not use individualized courses (PSY 408, 485, and 497) to meet this 15-unit upper-division requirement. Finally, you may only count up to 6 units of individualized courses within the 36-unit major. In addition, at least 15 of the 36 units required for this major must be from courses offered by NAU and may not include individualized courses.
