#### **PROGRAM INFORMATION**

Students may not use GER prefix courses to meet any liberal studies requirements.

\*GER Elective: Students must take 12 units from GER 401, 402, 403, 404, 405, 409, 411, or 412

Students may only take lower-level GER courses if you have not already taken advanced GER coursework. For instance, after you've completed 200-level GER courses, you can't take GER courses at the 100 level; after completing 300-level courses you can't take 100 or 200 level courses.

Students must earn a grade of C or better in any course they wish to apply towards their major in German.

Students are expected to pass the Zertifikat Deutsch als Fremdsprache exam with a score of gut or better before completing their undergraduate degree.

- All students are required to complete at least 120 total units which includes:
