Students may not use MUS or MUP prefixes courses to meet any liberal studies requirements.

*MUS or MUP Elective: 6 units of additional MUS or MUP courses with your advisor's consent (Note that you may count up to 3 units of MUP ensemble courses toward this requirement.)

**Large Ensemble: MUP 300-level major ensemble as assigned, through audition from MUP 350, 352, 353, 356, 357, 361, 362, 372, and 374 (5 units) Piano majors take MUP 374, and guitar majors take MUP 372.

***Private Lessons: 4 terms of lower-division private lessons. Students must complete a required exit performance exam in their last term of private lesson study.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All students are required to complete at least 120 total units which includes:
