

Second Emphasis Policy for Master of Administration

The Master of Administration program supports the idea of a student pursuing a second emphasis within the M. Admin. program. The second emphasis area is purely for the purpose of gaining additional knowledge in another area of study within the established program emphasis areas. The student will not receive a second master's degree

The student must declare the second emphasis before they start the capstone project. The student is required to complete 15 additional credits. The capstone must integrate the two emphasis areas. The capstone supervisor will coordinate with the coordinator of the second emphasis area.

When the student declares the second emphasis, there will be an additional fee of \$1000 due to the M Admin program, making the total program fee \$3500. The additional \$1000 will be prorated and attached to the foundation courses needed to complete the core requirements. If a student has completed all foundation courses the additional fee will be attached to the capstone class.

This policy will be reviewed one year after approval to determine its effectiveness.
