



Campus Recreation Inclement Weather Plan

Severe Weather/University Closure

- Campus Recreation is considered an essential service on campus. This means in the event of severe weather, the Recreation Center will remain open for student use
- In the event of severe weather or a University closure, each supervisor will contact their staff regarding a delayed opening time or implementation of the Inclement Weather Schedule
- **Recreation Center**
 - Hours: 9:00am – 9:00pm (weekdays) and 10am-5pm (weekends).
 - Fitness and climbing wall schedule will be reduced and subject to cancellation, please call for information.
 - During an inclement weather closure, **any campus recreation member (Recreation Center and Wall Aquatic Center) will have access** to the Recreation Center.
- **Wall Aquatic Center**
 - All operation will cease function during an NAU designated inclement weather closure. **All members of the Wall Aquatic Center will have complimentary access to the Recreation Center** during open hours (Weekdays 9am-9pm, Weekends 10am-5pm).

The campus community can visit nau.edu/alert, which will be updated in the event there is a change in the schedule. The decision will be made before 6 a.m., with the determination to cancel evening classes made by 4 p.m. The content on the page will not change if the university is operating on a normal schedule.

The university will send out an NAU Alert text message only in the event that classes or university operations are on a delayed start or canceled.
