In addition to the information found on the [Jacks are Back website](#), I have a few additional updates to share to help ensure a successful start to the fall semester.

- Visit [NAU Healthcheck](#) and take your daily health assessment. Before arriving on campus or participating in campus activities each day, all students, faculty, and staff must complete this COVID-19 assessment. NAU Healthcheck will help us return to campus safely and assist our community in reducing the spread of COVID-19.

- A number of new technologies are available to track exposure, save your spot in line, and safely order food. [Learn how NAU's technology updates will support health while prioritizing our educational mission.](#)

- This week, we opened a free walk-in COVID-19 testing site on campus, and administered more than 230 tests on day one. Visitors had a five-minute wait time, testing averaged just four minutes, and results will be available 24 to 72 hours after the lab receives the test. I encourage all students, faculty, staff, and community members to take advantage of this testing opportunity at NAU's University Union Fieldhouse, 1050 Knoles Drive. - NAU is providing care kits for all faculty, staff, and students. These kits include masks, hand sanitizer, and a thermometer for students. First-year students will receive their care kit when they pick up their Jacks Card. Upper-division students will receive theirs at check-in for on-campus housing, or at the Union or duBois information desks.
