Review of Student Teaching Evaluations

- NIET Aspiring Teacher Rubric
- Candidate Work Sample
- Cooperating Teacher Surveys (see https://nau.edu/pep/cooperating-teachers/)
- Based on feedback from Cooperating Teachers, we received recommendation to alter the scale for the Cooperating Teacher Surveys to allow for a "Developing" category that does not lead to an alert. For example, changing the scale to:
 - Not Applicable
 - 1 = Not Demonstrated to Expectation
 - 2 = Developing
 - 3 = Target



Recommendations Regarding Areas for Improvement

- Results from Exit Survey and New Teacher Survey, teacher candidates indicated they felt somewhat unprepared to:
 - 1) navigate school politics,
 - 2) work with school administrators, and
 - 3) explain student performance data to parents/guardians, students, and families.
- Do you have any recommendations regarding how to better address these work environment topics?



Other Areas for Improvement Identified by Cooperating Teachers

- Results from Special Education Cooperating Teaching Survey Responses:
 - a) Learn how to plan and implement specially designed instruction
 - b) Increased support from NAU
 - c) More coursework in dyslexia
