

2019 SPRING PERFORMANCE INFO

PERFORMANCES

Dancers will have the opportunity to perform in at least one performance on Saturday, June 1 in Ardrey Memorial Auditorium. The first half of each performance includes all Modern, Jazz and Hip-hop dancers, dance challenge solos, and dancers in Beginning Ballet and Pre-Primary. The second half will include ballet dancers in Primary & above performing excerpts from Swan Lake.

CASTS

Cast lists for both performances are posted in Ponderosa lobby.

PERFORMANCE FEES & TICKETS

All performers must pay a performance fee to pay for costume and facility rentals, and other associated performance costs such as teacher overtime, auditorium labor, etc. The fee for dancers in ballet, hip-hop **OR** jazz is \$50. A student taking ballet, modern, jazz or hip-hop is charged \$90. A student taking ballet, jazz, and hip-hop is charged \$120. If a dancer has not had any family or friends volunteer during the year an additional \$50 fee will be added. Checks can be made payable to "NAU Academy". Credit and debit card payments are also accepted.

Performance fees include two complimentary tickets for each dancer. Performance fees are due to the Academy office by the end of the day on Friday, April 19th. A list of paid dancers will be sent to the NAU Central Ticket Office at that time and tickets will go on sale at 10am on Monday, April 22. Forms and fees will still be accepted after April 19.

However, complimentary tickets cannot be obtained through the Box Office until forms and fees have been received by the Academy Office. In order for dancers to participate in the performance, fees must be paid by May 3.

VOLUNTEER JOBS

Volunteer sign-ups will be done online through a link sent via email and posted on the Academy website. **Parents/guardians of all participating dancers are expected to sign up for at least one job through the year. A \$50 fee will be added to the performance fees if a family member has not signed up to volunteer on behalf of the dancer through the 2018-2019 fall and spring.** There will be opportunities to volunteer at the Spring Performance.

EXTRA REHEARSALS

A performance week schedule is posted online and available to pick up in the Ponderosa lobby. Please make sure you understand when your dancer is required to arrive and be present for various spacing and/or dress rehearsals.

All dress rehearsals are held in the Ardrey Memorial Auditorium. Dressing rooms are in classrooms in the Performing & Fine Arts Building and backstage (directional signs will be posted).

Dress rehearsals are **CLOSED rehearsals; parents may **not** sit in the audience.

PHOTOGRAPHS & RECORDING

Photographs and video recordings will be permitted as long as they do not distract from the performance. Flash

photography is prohibited at all times. Classrooms will be reserved after each performance for more casual pictures with family, friends, etc.

COSTUMES

Costumes for the performances are rented to dancers by the Academy. Please note the following guidelines for required additional attire:

- All ballet dancers: light pink tights with feet and pink leather ballet shoes
- Jazz 1 & 2 dancers: black jazz shoes and tan tights
- Jazz 3, Modern & Hip-hop dancers: costume items will be discussed in class

HAIR

All dancers with long hair should have it neatly tied back. Classic-styled buns are required for girls in ballet classes. Use a hair net to keep the bun tidy.

MAKEUP

Dancers are not required to wear makeup but should they choose to do so, please adhere to guidelines:

LADIES

- Foundation slightly darker than skin, light mascara and blush, lipstick, no glitter
- Grade 4—Inter. Foundation: add earth-tone eye shadow, eyeliner
- Intermediate—Advanced 2: add earth-tone eye shadow, eyeliner, and eyelashes

GENTLEMEN

- Grade 4—Advanced 2: foundation slightly darker than skin, earth-tone eye shadow, mascara, eyeliner
