

CIDA 2019 Progress Report Data: Northern Arizona University- Flagstaff Mountain Campus

Student Achievement Data:

Northern Arizona University, Interior Design, Bachelors of Science in Interior Design

It typically takes a full-time student taking approximately 15 credits per semester four years to complete the degree program.

The following data was collected using institutional records and an alumni survey that was administered 4 months after the class of 2018 graduated. 16 out of 19 alumni responded to the survey.

Student Attrition and Retention

60% of the 45 students admitted in the fall of 2017 returned in the fall of 2018

Graduation Rates:

Current 4 year graduation rates within the program is 47.6% as of 4/4/2019.

Acceptance into Graduate Programs:

2 out of 19 students who graduated in 2018 applied for graduate school. 1 has been accepted and 1 is waiting to hear back.

Job Placement Rates:

14 of 19 students who graduated in 2018 are employed in interior design or a related profession. Recent graduates are practicing design in the areas of: Hospitality/Retail, Work space/Corporate, Residential, and Healthcare.
