WHAT DO I NEED FOR PRIVATE LESSONS?

1. Instrument, bow, rosin, shoulder rest or sponge (**remember this one!**), cleaning cloth (this should remain in your case)
2. A parent, especially if the student is young or in early books
3. Suzuki books, as well as etude, scale, and reading books
4. Nail clippers
5. Notebook for notes and assignments
6. Pencil
7. Enthusiasm!



WHAT DO I NEED AT HOME?

1. Suzuki CDs
2. Music stand
3. Quiet place to practice
4. Metronome
5. Appropriate performance attire
i.e. black pants, white shirt or blouse, black shoes & socks or panty-hose
6. Enthusiasm!

FOR GROUP LESSONS?

1. Pencil
2. Three-ring binder for handouts with paper for notes
3. Music stand
4. A Parent
5. Enthusiasm!



WHAT SHOULD I NOT DO?

1. **Never** leave instrument in the car for a long period of time
- e.g. leaving the instrument in the car while at work for a lesson that afternoon
2. **Do not** expose instrument to any form of extreme heat or cold
3. **Do not** get your instrument wet
4. **Do not** eat food and then play without washing hands
5. **Do not** place the instrument on the floor or somewhere it might be stepped or sat on
