The Department of Global Languages and Cultures announces the Borozan Memorial Modern Languages Scholarships for the Academic Year 2024/2025. \$17,585.27 will be awarded to **seven** qualified students. Each student will receive **\$2,512.18** disbursed as follows: **\$1,256.09** will be applied to their LOUIE accounts in *Fall 2024* and **\$1,256.09** will be applied in *Spring 2025*. If tuition is already paid, and a student has no outstanding charges in LOUIE, s/he may take this money in the form of a refund. Students must be full time **and attending both semesters** (current seniors should **NOT** apply unless they are an undergraduate planning on attending NAU for a degree in Spanish MAT). Travel is NOT required.

Other Regulations: All applicants must be accepted by NAU and attending full time (12 credit hrs minimum for Undergraduates and 9 credit hrs minimum for Graduates) during the Fall 2024 *AND* Spring 2025 terms. This scholarship will be awarded based on merit, academic accomplishments, and to undergraduate or graduate students who are pursuing a major **OR** minor in a Global Language (see NAU online catalog for qualifying majors and minors). Students must have a high school or college GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0-point scale and submit an *application by Monday, April 15, 2024.
