



Safety & Justice or **Misplaced Justice**

A conversation about community, police, and race

Join in a continued discussion about the police killings of over 100 unarmed black people in 2015. In many of these cases, there are questions about the legitimacy of armed officers using deadly force, and it seems that at least sometimes, justice has been misplaced. This misplaced justice carries with it racial, ethnic, sociological, and economic issues that are interrelated. This issue is difficult to talk about. Because it can be uncomfortable, communities are sometimes silent. This Pathways will play a part in breaking that silence and create an opportunity for students and community members to engage in deliberation about what the implications are for social justice, economic justice, and will conclude with a consideration of what justice is.
