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"YOUR BODY BELONGS TO THE EARTH." —THÍCH NHẤT HẠNH

BARE FEET IN EARTH, HANDS OUTSTRETCHED FOR RAIN...A COMMUNITY PULSATING TOWARD THEIR MOST PROFOUND SACRIFICE—FOR THE CONTINUANCE OF ALL LIFE, FOR WINTER TO TURN TO SPRING. THIS PIECE OF PHYSICAL THEATER TO PETER STOPSCHINSKI'S SCORE THE "MASSACRE OF SPRING" REIMAGINES THE ORIGINAL *LE SACRE DU PRINTEMPS*, COMPOSED BY IGOR STRAVINSKY AND CHOREOGRAPHED BY VASLAV NIJINSKY. NAU'S DEPARTMENT OF THEATRE BRINGS YOU A SENSORIAL EXPLORATION OF BODIES, ENVIRONMENT, RITUAL, AND SACRIFICE—A CELEBRATORY ODE TO LIFE.

IN 2010, I EXPERIENCED A MOST AMAZING PERFORMANCE BY THE FOURTH YEAR ACTING STUDENTS OF THE MOSCOW ART THEATRE SCHOOL (MXAT). "STRAVINSKY GAMES." WAS CHOREOGRAPHED BY MXAT'S HEAD OF MOVEMENT ALLA SIGALOVA, HONORED ARTIST OF RUSSIA. I HAD NEVER SEEN AN ENSEMBLE OF ACTORS (OR DANCERS) SO FULLY ALIVE, SO FULLY 'ON ACTION' IN SERVICE TO THE STORY. EVERY FIBER OF THEIR BEING WAS ON FIRE, AWAKENING THE PRIMAL AND PRICKLING THE SKIN OF EVERYONE IN THE AUDITORIUM. WHAT AN EDUCATION FOR THE ACTOR!, I THOUGHT.

WITNESSING SIGALOVA'S "STRAVINSKY. GAMES." WAS ALL THE MORE POWERFUL FOR ME SINCE MY FAVORITE PIECE OF THEATRE WAS (AND STILL IS) PINA BAUSCH'S FRÜHLINGSOPFER, CHOREOGRAPHED IN 1975. AND SO I ASKED SIGLAOVA TO BE MY MENTOR; AND, THE FOLLOWING YEAR I LIVED ABROAD AND STUDIED HER METHODS OF CREATING MOVEMENT FOR THE EDUCATION OF THE ACTOR. DURING THIS TIME I LEARNED THAT SIGALOVA'S INSPIRATION CAME FROM HER MENTOR—THE ONE AND ONLY PINA BAUSCH.

MANY YEARS LATER I MET A BRILLIANT COMPOSER BY THE NAME OF PETER STOPSCHINSKI, WHO HAD CREATED HIS OWN VERSION OF *THE RITE OF SPRING*. LISTENING TO HIS THRILLING, WHIMSICAL, AND AT TIMES TERRIFYING SCORE, I FELT COMPELLED TO BRING HIS "MASSACRE OF SPRING" TO LIFE...TO STAND ON THE SHOULDERS OF MENTORS AND CREATE MY OWN RITE OF SPRING, AND HERE WE ARE!

THIS PIECE IS FIRST AND FOREMOST A FULL-BODIED EDUCATION FOR ACTORS, AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR DESIGNERS TO GO BOLDLY BEYOND LINEAR, NARRATIVE STORYTELLING. IT IS ALSO A DEEP ROMP INTO THE EXPERIENCE OF A COMMUNITY FOR WHOM THE EARTH IS A MOST VALUABLE MEMBER. THÍCH NHẤT HẠNH WRITES THAT YOUR BODY BELONGS TO THE EARTH, AND TO ONE ANOTHER—

"THE TREES, THE CLOUDS, THE SOIL, AND EVERY LIVING THING BROUGHT ABOUT THE PRESENCE OF YOUR BODY...ALL THAT YOU EAT HAS PULLED UP NUTRITION FROM THE SOIL IN ORDER TO GROW. IN THE SOIL ARE MANY PEOPLE WHO HAVE DIED, HAVE BEEN TRANSFORMED, AND HAVE BECOME PART OF THE SOIL. MAYBE IN THIS MOUTHFUL OF RICE ARE ALSO THE BONES OF MANY HUNDREDS OF GENERATIONS AS WELL AS MANY DEAD LEAVES, WORMS, AND ANIMAL BONES."

WHAT WOULD IT BE LIKE TO LIVE MORE FULLY IN OUR BODIES? AND TO ALLOW OUR BODIES TO FULLY SENSE ONE ANOTHER AND THE NATURAL WORLD OF WHICH WE ARE INEXTRICABLY CONNECTED? WHAT MIGHT IT BE LIKE TO LIVE IN A COMMUNITY THAT IS SPIRITUALLY EMBODIED AND LIVING IN THE TRUTH OF INTERDEPENDENCE? AND, WHAT DOES SACRIFICE MEAN TO THOSE LIVING IN A WORLD WHERE THE BODY'S LIFE IS SO VIBRANTLY VALUED?

THESE ARE THE QUESTIONS THAT HAVE EMPOWERED US ON OUR JOURNEY INTO THE AWE-INSPIRING SURGE THAT IS SPRING, THAT IS THE CYCLE OF LIFE. MY HOPE IS THAT THE PERFORMANCE MIGHT AWAKEN A SLIVER OF WHAT RUDOLF OTTO DESCRIBES AS MYSTERIUM TREMENDUM—THE GREAT AND OVERWHELMING, SALVATION-BESTOWING POWER OF GOD/NATURE...AND OUR BODIES.






