International Study Options for Honors Students

- Look into your options for earning Honors credits or fulfilling your Honors Capstone abroad.

Ways to earn Honors Credit Abroad:

Faculty Led Program	Work with the faculty leader of the trip to include an HON component to the course to turn it into an Honors course.	Honors Study Abroad form- please check the "faculty led" box. IGP Must be enrolled in the IGP program	IGP or GSEP or GLBP students have the option to earn either three or six units while abroad. For three units choose ONE of the following options: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discussion leader for other IGP/GSEP/GLBP students for Fall Three Essay response for internship for Spring For six units of –H credit, you will do BOTH of the above: discussion leader in Fall and three essays for internships in Spring.	Honors Study Abroad form- please check the "IGP" box. You will also need to specify three or six units of HON credit. *Note: If you are using your IGP internship for Honors Capstone units, please see the section below on Capstones.	April 1 prior to departure
Exchanges/ USAC and other Provider Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Three-essay option: Write a series of three essays documenting your study abroad experiences. Unique prompts are forwarded to you upon approval. Take a designated Honors course at the host institution abroad or domestically. *Note: Very few foreign institutions offer this option. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Honors Study Abroad form- please check the "Three Essay Option" box. Submit course descriptions for your intended courses abroad. 	No less than two weeks prior to departure

Ways to use Study Abroad to fulfill the Honors Capstone Requirement:

Before submitting any of the following forms for review, you must have an approved Honors Capstone Proposal on file in the Honors College. Your Honors Capstone coursework detailed below should be specified in this Capstone proposal. Please note that only four credits earned abroad may be used in fulfillment of the Honors Capstone.

Faculty Led Program	Work with the faculty leader of the trip to include an HON component to the course to turn it into an Honors course. You may only use up to <u>four</u> units of faculty led credits in fulfillment of the Honors Capstone.	Honors Study Abroad form- please check the "Honors Capstone" box. You MUST attach a syllabus and a brief proposal identifying Honors component.	Four weeks prior to departure
IGP	IGP or GSEP or GLBP students may only use up to <u>four</u> units of internship credits ex: (SPA408H, GER408H) in fulfillment of the Honors Capstone. Honors credits may be earned through an additional assignment. Unique prompts will be sent upon approval. Note: The LAN Honors credits offered in the fall are not applicable to the Honors Capstone, but can be used for Honors units.	Honors Study Abroad form- please check the "IGP" and "Honors Capstone" box.	April 1 prior to departure
GRIP (Research or Internships Abroad)	GRIP students may only use up to <u>four</u> units of internship credit in fulfillment of the Honors Capstone. Honors credits may be earned through an additional assignment. Unique prompts will be sent upon approval. *Note: Internship credits earned abroad must follow CIE GRIP credit guidelines.	Honors Study Abroad form- please check the "GRIP" and "Honors Capstone" box.	Four weeks prior to departure
HON 491C- Honors Capstone Abroad	<u>Three</u> Honors Capstone credits may be earned through this option. The HON 491C is an online course taken during the semester abroad. You will sign up for this course in addition to the other credits earned abroad. Your study abroad program must be at least four weeks long.	Honors 491C form. Check the "Honors Capstone Abroad" box.	Four weeks prior to departure
