Announcing New Scholarship Opportunity

Ray Madden Scholars

Each year, starting with January 2016 applications for August 2016 admission to our Master's program, the Department of Anthropology at Northern Arizona University will award two Ray Madden scholarships in the amount of \$25,000 for the first year, renewable for a second year at \$23,000 with demonstrated progress in the program.

We seek Anthropology students with strong potential for professional success who would not otherwise have the opportunity to pursue an MA degree at NAU.

One scholarship will be awarded in Archaeology or Biological Anthropology; and
One scholarship will be awarded in Sociocultural or Linguistic Anthropology.

The Madden scholarship is meant to cover resident tuition and allowances for books, class fees, travel, summer research or internship expenses, and a modest living stipend. Non-residents of Arizona should apply in addition for the WRGP program or a non-resident tuition waiver.
