

B.S.-M.S. Integrated Degree Progression in Geography, Planning and Recreation

To complete both degrees within 5 years, an efficient student will need to enroll in at least 21 units (7 courses) in Summer and Winter Sessions.

Below are examples of Degree Progressions (or Programs of Study) for each of the B.S. degrees offered in the department. These are examples only, as each student will likely vary in their personal progress.

B.S. Geography Track

- Liberal Studies Courses = 35 units - B.S. Courses = 42 units
