

What Graduate Assistants Need to Know About Student Health Insurance

In order to receive the health insurance benefit, a graduate assistant must:

- 1. Be officially hired as a Northern Arizona University graduate assistant and have a signed letter of appointment on file in the Graduate College of Northern Arizona University;**
- 2. Be enrolled for a minimum of nine graduate-level credit hours for the semester; and have one graduate assistantship appointment, for 20 hours per week, for the entire semester.**
- 3. Be enrolled in the United Health Care major-medical student health insurance plan.**
 - You can enroll when you register for classes by calling the Fronske Health Center at 523-6343 or by visiting their website. Enrollment for student health insurance closes 14 days after classes begin.
 - Please check your student account on LOUIE to verify your insurance enrollment.
 - You will receive a student health insurance enrollment card for each semester. The enrollment card will be issued within thirty days after classes begin.
 - You must enroll separately for the fall and spring semesters!
