ACCELERATED PROGRAM: **BSEd History – MA History (Extended Coursework with Public History Track)**

Overview

Note: This plan includes 12 units that are used to complete both the undergraduate and the graduate requirements: 6 at the undergraduate level and 6 at the graduate level. Students must receive a grade of “B” or higher in this coursework used towards both degrees.

 - Politics, Economy, and Culture
 - Indigeneity and Colonialism
 - Environment and Health
 - Borderlands and U.S. West

[HIS 498C](#) (3 units) is required - it may be applied here if it relates to the primary field or below under *Third field coursework*.

*You may take up to 12 units of primary field.

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Track requirements (Extended Coursework with Public History Track) (15-18 units):

- Public History secondary field elective chosen in consultation with your advisor (3 units)
- Third field coursework (3-6 units)
 - one additional 400-level [HIS](#) course that relates to the third field coursework or cognate, excluding [HIS 407](#), [HIS 429](#), [HIS 430](#) and [HIS 466](#) (3 units)
 - [HIS 498C](#) (3 units) may be applied here if not already applied in the primary field core requirement.

• You must have an approved portfolio and you must pass a comprehensive final examination covering the courses taken. The comprehensive exam will have written and oral components, and it will be structured by the program committee.
