

Message from the Executive Director:

Welcome to the 2012 edition of the Annual Yield. I hope you will enjoy leafing through this yearbook, both now and many years in the future when you are feeling a bit nostalgic about your time here in the School of Forestry!

As always, our students, faculty and staff have had a busy and productive year. Probably the highlight for the 19 students who were able to make the trip was the Society of American Foresters National Convention, which was held this year in Waikiki. The students clearly enjoyed themselves, but also got some good business done there. All of the students spent time in sessions and at our School of Forestry exhibit, plus a record 5 students were offered positions there through the Forest Service's on-the-spot hiring program. It was an active year for all of our student clubs. The Forestry Club/Student Chapter of the SAF represented us very well in



Hawaii, performed a wide range of service on behalf of the School of Forestry and the community, and met regularly with the professional members of Northern Arizona Chapter of the SAF. The Timber Sports team continues to grow and this year competed in yet another very wet conclave, this time in Corvallis, Oregon. Our SAFE and *Xi Sigma Pi* chapters also were active in various ways, ranging from participation in a conference in Santa Fe to donating a new set of increment corers to our school. Our clubs are one of the real strengths of the School of Forestry.

Among the faculty and staff, we had fewer comings and goings than usual. However, we did lose two staff members who had served the School of Forestry very well. JJ Smith, our Centennial Forest Manager and a highly regarded teacher, took a leave of absence to work in Afghanistan last spring and has decided to stay on there. Also, April Sandoval, our Administrative Associate, left at the end of the academic year to take a position in the Graduate College. For over five years, April did an outstanding job on behalf of everyone associated with the School of Forestry and she will be sorely missed. On a happier note, we had four notable promotions among our faculty, including Paul Beier (to Regents' Professor, the highest academic rank at NAU), Yeon-Su Kim (to Full Professor) and Ching-Hsun Huang and Kristen Waring (both to Associate Professor with Tenure).

While this was a good year overall, it will also be remembered for the death of Levi Mitchell during the fall semester. Levi was in Semester A at the time; he was a very good student academically and was clearly well liked by his fellow students. He was also a veteran who had served his country in Iraq. We are planning to plant a Douglas-fir tree in his memory near the School of Forestry building this coming fall.

Finally, I'd like to thank Erin Saunders for once again putting together a very nice edition of our yearbook. This year she was ably assisted by her student worker, Stephanie Polk.
