

## Getting started:

While it is only required that students be in the CCC2NAU program for one semester prior to their transition to NAU, we find students have the most success when they start the program as they are enrolling in their first semester of CCC coursework. This is the best way to maximize the program's benefits!

### **Quick Start:**

1. Apply to CCC
  2. Apply to CCC2NAU
  3. Complete the online Info Session
  4. Meet with a CCC2NAU advisor
  5. Register and pay for classes
1. Apply to Coconino Community College by filling out the online [application](#). If you have questions about the application process, call 928-226-4320.
  2. Apply to CCC2NAU; scroll down to "[Apply to CCC2NAU.](#)" Take note that if you already applied to NAU, just let us know and we can adjust your application accordingly.
  3. Complete the required online [Info Session](#) and agreement form.
  4. Make an initial advising appointment after April 1<sup>st</sup> with a CCC2NAU advisor by [scheduling online](#) or by calling 928-226-4323.

## **Bring the following items to determine math & English placement:**

- ❖ A copy of your SAT or ACT scores OR
- ❖ A copy of your English and math placement test scores. [Placement tests](#) can be taken at CCC before your advising appointment OR
- ❖ Unofficial transcripts from high school and/or any colleges or university you attended prior to CCC.

## **Additional to-do items:**

- ❖ Send official final high school transcript to CCC
- ❖ Send official AP test scores, if you have them, to CCC
- ❖ Send official transcripts from any colleges or universities you attended prior to CCC. Official transcripts are in sealed envelopes or you can have them sent electronically to CCC.

**Remember that CCC2NAU advisors see students on an appointment basis only. Be sure to make your appointment in advance by [scheduling online](#) or by calling (928) 226-4323.**

### **Paying for classes:**

Click [here](#) to see when CCC requires payment. Students can pay by cash, credit card, or through financial aid that has been awarded. [Tuition](#) rates are determined by residency. There is also a [payment plan](#) option available for students to pay in installments.

### **Financial Aid:**

If you are submitting a FAFSA to apply for financial aid, be sure to choose CCC as your parent institution. CCC’s Title IV school code is 031004. ### **Scholarships:**

CCC’s Foundation [scholarship application](#) opens in mid-December each year and closes in early to mid-March. We encourage all CCC2NAU students to apply for scholarships as there are several scholarships dedicated for just CCC2NAU students.

### **Bookstore:**

After you register for classes at CCC, check out CCC’s bookstore to purchase your books. You can bring your schedule in to purchase books or you can purchase online through the bookstore [website](#).

### **Student ID cards:**

Once you’ve paid for your classes or completed your financial aid file, go to CCC’s Security Desk to obtain your free CCC student ID card. Once you’ve cleared your immunization hold at NAU, see your CCC2NAU advisor for a free JacksCard voucher.

### **Parking:**

If you plan to drive to CCC’s campus, you will need a parking permit. Parking permits are \$60 a year or \$40 per semester. You can get a parking application and pay for your permit at Student Accounts. Overnight parking is not an option at CCC. If you need to park on NAU’s campus, you can view purchasing options and pricing on NAU’s parking services [website](#). With your JacksCard ride the Mountain Line bus route 10 around NAU’s campus for free.

### **Housing:**

CCC2NAU students have the option to live in NAU residence halls. Log in to NAU’s [Housing Portal](#) to apply. Students are encouraged to apply now for the 2020-2021 academic year. Please review the CCC2NAU [Housing FAQ](#) for more information. We encourage students to explore housing options as early as possible and to include housing costs in your financial planning for college. Because Coconino Community College does not provide on-campus housing, students and families will need to plan proactively. Click [here](#) for other housing options in Flagstaff.

### **Meal plans:**

### **Proof of Immunizations:**

Since NAU is a residential campus all students must submit [proof of two measles/mumps/rubella \(MMR\) vaccines](#) to NAU's Campus Health Services. Upload your immunization record at [campushealth.nau.edu](http://campushealth.nau.edu) using your NAU login. If you will be completing an online degree at NAU, you will not need to clear this immunization hold.

### **Other:**

- In order to stay in good standing with CCC2NAU, you must complete the required online Info Session and meet with a CCC2NAU advisor for Initial Advising. You also have to enroll in classes at CCC in the semester you applied. If you do not complete these required steps you will be removed from the program. If you can't enroll in the semester you applied, let a CCC2NAU advisor know. You can always enroll in a later semester and we will defer your application.
- Are you coming from out of town? We recommend making your Initial Advising appointment with a CCC2NAU advisor on the same day as placement testing to maximize your visit. We do provide phone advising but it is in your best interest to make an in person advising appointment.
