Information for New Students

In light of COVID-19, advisors are offering appts via zoom. Please see below.

Getting started:

While it is only required that students be in the CCC2NAU program for one semester prior to their transition to NAU, we find students have the most success when they start the program as they are enrolling in their first semester of CCC coursework. This is the best way to maximize the program's benefits!

Quick Start:

1. Apply to CCC
2. Apply to CCC2NAU
3. Complete the online Info Session
4. Meet with a CCC2NAU advisor
5. Register and pay for classes

1. Apply to Coconino Community College by filling out the online [application](#).
2. Apply to [CCC2NAU](#). Note: If you already applied to NAU, let us know and we can adjust your application accordingly.
3. Complete the required online [Info Session](#) and agreement form.
4. Make an initial advising Zoom appointment with a CCC2NAU advisor by [scheduling](#) a zoom appt. Be sure to set up your [myccc](#) beforehand.
5. Bookmark the college's important [dates and deadlines](#) so you know payment deadlines and last days to add/drop classes.

Things to do to determine your math & English placement:

- ❖ Complete the quick, online [self-placement test](#) to assess your skills & write down your results
- ❖ Have a copy of your SAT or ACT scores OR an unofficial copy of your high school transcript
- ❖ Have a copy of your unofficial transcripts from any colleges or universities you attended already
- ❖ Check out the [self-placement math and English videos](#) to confirm where you best fit

Additional to-do items:

- ❖ Send your official **final** high school transcript to CCC.
- ❖ If you obtained a GED, click [here](#) to send your test scores to CCC.
- ❖ Send official AP test scores, if you have them, to CCC.
- ❖ Send official transcripts from any colleges or universities you attended prior to CCC. Official transcripts are in sealed envelopes or you can have them sent electronically to CCC.

Paying for Classes:

Click [here](#) to see when CCC requires payment. Be sure to pay (or have financial aid fully in place) before the deadline or you will be dropped from your classes. Students can pay by cash, credit card, or through financial aid that has been awarded. There is also a [payment plan](#) option available for students to pay in installments for a fee. [Tuition](#) rates are determined by [residency](#). Be sure you are in the cheapest rate! If not, contact [Registration and Enrollment Services](#) to discuss your residency.

Financial Aid:

If you are submitting a FAFSA to apply for financial aid, be sure to choose CCC as your parent institution. CCC’s Title IV school code is 031004. Scholarships:

CCC’s Foundation [scholarship application](#) opens in mid-December each year and closes in mid-March. We encourage all CCC2NAU students to apply for scholarships as there are several scholarships dedicated for just CCC2NAU students.

Bookstore:

After you register for classes at CCC, check out CCC’s bookstore to purchase your books. You can purchase online through the bookstore [website](#).

Student ID Cards:

Remember you “belong” to two campuses, which means you can get two ID cards. Once you’ve registered for classes, go to CCC’s Security Desk to obtain your free CCC student ID card. Your CCC ID card is how you will access Cline Library. Once you’ve cleared your immunization hold at NAU, email your CCC2NAU advisor for a free JacksCard voucher to obtain your NAU ID card.

Parking:

If you plan to drive to CCC’s campus, you will need a parking permit. You can purchase your permit [online](#). Overnight parking is not an option at CCC. If you need to park on NAU’s campus, you can view purchasing options and pricing on [NAU’s parking services](#). With your JacksCard, you can ride the Mountain Line bus route 10 around NAU’s campus for free.

Housing:

CCC2NAU students have the option to live in NAU residence halls. Log in to NAU’s [Housing Portal](#) to apply. Students can apply now to live on campus for the 2021-2022 academic year and can select a roommate. Please review the CCC2NAU [Housing FAQ](#) for more information. We encourage students to explore housing options as early as possible and to include housing costs in your financial planning for college. Because Coconino Community College does not provide on-campus housing, students and families will need to plan proactively. Click [here](#) (and scroll down) for other housing options in Flagstaff.

Meal plans:

Students interested in purchasing a meal plan to use on NAU's campus may do so by contacting [Campus Dining](#).

Proof of Immunizations:

Since NAU is a residential campus all students must submit [proof of two measles/mumps/rubella \(MMR\) vaccines](#) to NAU's Campus Health Services. Upload your immunization record at campushealth.nau.edu using your NAU login. If you will be completing an online degree at NAU and don't intend to live on campus, you will not need to clear this immunization hold.

You also have to enroll in classes at CCC in the semester you applied. If you do not complete these required steps you will be removed from the program. If you can't enroll in the semester you applied, let a CCC2NAU advisor know. You can always enroll in a later semester and we will defer your application.

Coconino Community College's Lone Tree Campus is located just one mile south of Northern Arizona University's southern edge of campus. CCC is currently open for limited services. Park in the visitor's parking spot for a quick visit or obtain a free parking pass at the Security Desk (the first office on the right as you enter the building). Enter by the door near the flag pole.
