Getting started:

While it is only required that students be in the CCC2NAU program for one semester prior to their transfer to NAU, we find students have the most success when they start the program as they are enrolling in their first semester at CCC. This is the best way to maximize the program's benefits!

Quick Start:

1. Apply to CCC
2. Apply to CCC2NAU
3. Complete the online Info Session
4. Meet with a CCC2NAU advisor
5. Register and pay for classes

1. Apply to Coconino Community College by filling out the online [application](#).
2. Apply to [CCC2NAU](#). Note: If you already applied to attend NAU full-time, let us know and we can adjust your application to CCC2NAU.
3. [Schedule](#) a new student advising appointment for **after April 10th** which is when students can register at CCC. Be sure to set up your [myccc](#) account beforehand.
4. Bookmark the college's important [dates and deadlines](#) so you know payment deadlines and last days to add/drop classes.
5. Set up your NAU account by calling the [Student Technology Center](#).

Determine your math & English placement:

- ❖ Take the required [Self-Assessment Placement questionnaire](#) to determine which classes to take

Additional to-do items:

- ❖ Send your official **final** high school transcript to CCC
- ❖ If you obtained a GED, click [here](#) to send your test scores to CCC
- ❖ Send official AP test scores, if you have them, to CCC and to NAU
- ❖ Send official transcripts to CCC from any colleges or universities you previously attended
 - ❖ Official transcripts are sent electronically or in a sealed envelope

Paying for classes:

Click [here](#) to see when CCC requires payment. Be sure to pay (or have financial aid fully in place) before the deadline or you will be dropped from your classes. Students can pay by cash, credit card, or through financial aid that has been awarded. There is also a [payment plan](#) option available for students to pay in installments for a fee. [Tuition](#) rates are determined by [residency](#). Be sure you are in the cheapest rate! If not, contact [Registration and Enrollment Services](#) to discuss your residency.

Financial Aid:

If you are submitting a FAFSA to apply for financial aid, be sure to choose CCC as your parent institution. CCC's Title IV school code is 031004. Scholarships:

CCC's Foundation [scholarship application](#) opens in mid-December each year and closes in late February. We encourage all CCC2NAU students to apply for scholarships as there are several scholarships dedicated for just CCC2NAU students.

Bookstore:

After you register for classes at CCC, check out [CCC's bookstore](#) to purchase books.

Proof of immunizations:

Since NAU is a residential campus, all students must submit proof of two MMR vaccines (measles/mumps/rubella) to NAU's Campus Health Services. Upload your immunization records [here](#) using your NAU login. If you will be doing an online degree at NAU and/or don't intend to live on campus, you don't need to clear this hold.

Student ID cards:

Remember you "belong" to two campuses which means you can get two ID cards. Once you've registered for classes, go to CCC's Security Desk to obtain your free CCC student ID card. Your CCC ID card is how you will access Cline Library. Once you've cleared your immunization hold at NAU, email your CCC2NAU advisor for a free JacksCard voucher to obtain your NAU JacksCard.

Transportation:

If you plan to drive to CCC's campus, you will need a parking permit. You can purchase your permit [online](#). Overnight parking is not an option at CCC. If you need to park on NAU's campus, you can view options and pricing [here](#). With your NAU JacksCard, you can ride the Mountain Line bus route 10 around NAU's campus for free. Mountain Line routes 4 (Gold) and 14 (Brown) both stop at Lone Tree Road in front of CCC's campus. CCC's Fourth Street Campus has convenient access from routes 7 (Purple) and 2 (Blue).

Housing:

CCC2NAU students have the option to live in NAU residence halls. Log in to NAU's [Housing Portal](#) to apply. Students can now apply for the 2023-2024 academic year. Students may be able to select a roommate that is another CCC2NAU student. Please review the [Housing FAQ](#) carefully. We encourage you to explore housing options as early as possible and to include [housing costs](#) in your financial planning for college. Because CCC does not provide on-campus housing, students will need to plan proactively. Click [here](#) (and scroll down) for alternative housing options in Flagstaff.

Meal plans:

Be sure to meet with a CCC2NAU advisor for [Initial Advising](#) any time after April 10th. You also must enroll in classes at CCC in the semester you applied. If you do not complete these requirements, you may be removed from the program. However, if you can't enroll in the semester you applied, let a CCC2NAU advisor know. You can always enroll in a later term, and we will happily defer your application.

Getting to Coconino Community College

Coconino Community College's Lone Tree Campus is located just one mile south of Northern Arizona University's southern edge of campus. If you are visiting CCC's campus, park in the visitor's parking spot for a quick visit or obtain a free parking pass at the Security Desk (the first office on the right as you enter the building). Enter by the door near the flagpole.
