Directions - From I-17 Northbound

- Take exit 341 to E. McConnell Dr.
- Turn right onto E. McConnell Dr.
- Turn immediately right onto E Pine Knoll Dr.
- Turn left after the Rolle Activity Center
- Proceed through the parking lot 45 to the front of the Du Bois Center

Location & Parking

The Du Bois Center is located at 306 E. Pine Knoll Dr., behind the Rolle Activity Center.

CM guests may register for a digital parking pass by visiting https://nau.pmreserve.com/ (step by step instructions are provided below). Here is your parking code: FY242910380f25

The closest parking lot to the Du Bois Center is lot P44, P45, P45A and P63. However, your parking pass is valid in any employee parking lots (blue). When parking, please park with your license plate facing outwards.

Friendly Reminders – How to avoid getting a parking citation

NAU Parking Services is rather strict on their parking guidelines and rules, please read the following common errors made, to avoid getting a parking warning or citation. Please visit their <u>website</u> for more detailed regulations.

CM Dept. is not responsible for any citations received and will not pay or reimburse for any parking citations

- It can take up to two hours for the pass to become effective, please plan accordingly.
- Park with your license plate facing out, we recommend NOT pulling through unless you have a matching front license plate.
- This parking pass is only valid for NON NAU registered vehicles (no student, staff, or faculty vehicles).
- If you have a rental vehicle always double check the license plate state.
- Do not enter spaces when entering license plate number.





Driving/Direction Map & Parking Map Parking Lots are circled in red.




Please enter the date and times of your visit. While it does say hour, it is utilized like a clock.

Please enter the access code you have been provided, then click update. FY242910380f25 IT IS CASE AND SPACE SENSTIVE.


Next, select Add to Cart:




The next screen you will see will request your information to authenticate your parking.




Please enter all red asterisked fields, then click Complete Purchase:
