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



14 week, 300 clock hours of instruction designed to prepare students the coding rules for the CPT, ICD-10 and Level II coding systems and then applying the rules to code patient services, as well as usage of a variety of payment systems. .







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Nursing Assistant





A 6 weeks, 153 clock hours of instruction designed to prepare students for certification as a Nursing Assistant. NA is a licensed caretaker who assists in performing activities of daily living to persons in skilled nursing facilities, hospitals, and/or doctor's offices.



E C 3 week with a total of 75 clock hours designed to prepare students the skill of assisting clients with their activities of daily living, light housekeeping and meal preparation. Caregivers are frequently employed in Assisted Living facilities, and Home Health/Hospice agencies.

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



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
