Telehealth Nursing




- Patient not required to be physically present.
- Professional nursing
- Provides access, care management, education, and other health related needs
- Duty to provide safe care

Nursing Standards

Care management and coordination is a responsibility of, and a standard of practice for, all registered nurses.

- Advocates for patient
- Coordinates, integrates, and assures continuity of care
- Communicates care provided and needed at each transition in care
- Engages patients, caregivers, and providers using an interprofessional approach
- Uses the unique and complementary abilities of all members of the team to help attain desired outcomes

Advanced Practice Registered Nurse



Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN)

- Registered Nurse Practitioner (RNP)
 - FNP, AGNP, WHNP, PMHNP, PNP, NNP
- Certified Nurse Midwife
- Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS)
- Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA).

Nurse Practitioner (NP)

Scope of practice of a registered nurse... plus:

- Examine a patient and establish a medical diagnosis
- Admit, manage, discharge to a health care facility
- Order, interpret, perform diagnostic tests
- Prescribe, order, administer, and dispense
 - pharmacologic interventions
 - non-pharmacological interventions (e.g., DME, home health, hospice, PT, OT)
- Manage the plan of care
