LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Northern Arizona University sits on the base of the San Francisco Peaks, on ancestral homelands sacred to Indigenous Nations throughout the region. We honor their past, present, and future generations, who have lived here for millennia and we will forever call this place home.

OVERVIEW OF THE INDIGENOUS STOLE

Since 1994, the Indigenous staff and faculty have honored the achievements of Indigenous students who self-identify as Native American, Alaska Native, and in recent years, Native Hawaiian and who are graduating from Northern Arizona University. The Office of Indigenous Student Success along with the Office of Native American Initiatives (ONAI) colleagues continue the tradition of giving complimentary stoles to Indigenous graduates. The round design is a combined graphic that represents the 4 R's – Relationships (feather/four directions), Respect (water), Resilience (corn stalk/growth), and Responsibility (sun).

The four Rs align with ONAI's mission: "Cultivate effective and inclusive content to communicate NAU's unparalleled commitment to respect, responsibility, relationships, and resilience of Native American/Indigenous cultures while expanding educational opportunities to sovereign nations." The 4R + Relationships: Four cardinal directions considered sacred in Native American cultures. The feathers represent the trust, honor, wisdom, and strength necessary for establishing and cultivating relationships. Responsibility: Sun graphic illustrates responsibility by showing the effect that it has by reaching out its rays. It also signifies the beginning of a new day as it rises from the east. Both express dependability and accountability, essential parts of responsibility. Respect: The water graphic uses a water droplet shape that is utilized in Native American jewelry and other inspired circular designs. Water is used here to visually express the importance of respect and the value of community approval and honor. Resilience The corn is a resilient crop. The corn stalk symbolizes the growth students experience through support in their education.
