AGEC Requirements: What is an AGEC? The Arizona General Education Curriculum (AGEC) is a 35 credit general education block that fulfills the same lower division general education requirement at all three state universities. Follow hyperlink for more information.

Interdisciplinary Studies Requirements - (*Multi-use credits, may also fill AGEC or Associate degree requirements.*) \*

Communications Block (6 credits): One theory-based and one performance-based communication course required.

Choose between a Foreign Language Requirement Option or a Science Requirement Option.

Foreign Language (16 credits): You must demonstrate proficiency in a language other than English that is equivalent to four terms of university coursework in the same language. You may satisfy this requirement by taking language courses or by testing out of all or part of it by taking CLEP, or other exams.

**AND**

Computer Literacy (3 credits): . This coursework must help you to understand, in general, the technical components of computers and information systems, how to solve problems using information systems technology, word processing, spreadsheet use, database management, graphic information software, website development, graphic design and use of statistical analysis software. Subject to advisor approval. Choose Introduction to Computer Information Systems or similar course.

**OR**

Science (12 credits): take at least 12 units from courses with Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Sciences, Geology, Mathematics, Nutrition, Physical Science, Physics, or Statistics prefixes. Please note that other courses must be approved by the program director. Some of these credits will be filled with the lab science courses and math requirements of the AGEC.

**AND**

Computer Literacy (6 credits): . This coursework must help you to understand, in general, the technical components of computers and information systems, how to solve problems using information systems technology, word processing, spreadsheet use, database management, graphic information software, website development, graphic design and use of statistical analysis software. Subject to advisor approval. Choose Introduction to Computer Information Systems or similar course, plus one addition CIS course more advanced than the introductory
