* 75 credits of Associate degree coursework, AGEC, and Cognates may transfer to NAU, requiring only 45 credits be completed at NAU. Please work with your community college advisor and your <u>NAU Transfer Representative</u> to optimize transfer.

Admission requirements include a "B" or better in SW 220 – Introduction to Social Work or equivalent course, as well as a minimum gpa of 2.25 and 24 credits or more completed or in progress. * NAU's BSW is available in person in Flagstaff and Yuma, or Online. NAU offers two MSW/Master of Social Work graduate degree programs: 2-year MSW (for those who have NOT completed a BSW program) and 1-year MSW - Advanced Standing (for those who have completed a BSW program). Completion of NAU's BSW with a GPA of 3.3 or better prepares students for the accelerated-based, 1-year, MSW - Advanced Standing program. Admission to NAU's MSW must be within 5 years of completion of the BSW.
