PURPOSE

To define regulations that govern procurement.

POLICY

PUR 201-00-01: General Information

University procurements, regardless of funding source, will be made in accordance with applicable state statutes, federal regulations, and Board of Regents and University policy. Contracting and Purchasing Services has the responsibility to ensure policy compliance. The Director of Procurement has the central responsibility for establishing procedures and guidelines that will assist users in complying with procurement policies.
