NAU's University Policy Program

Northern Arizona University's effort to revise and refresh its university-level policy system continues. New Policy Spotlight

Appropriate Use of IT Resources

All NAU faculty, staff, and students must know and comply with the rules that govern use of the University's information technology resources, including its computers, networks, email systems, and data assets. The University's [Appropriate Use of IT Resources](#) policy provides this guidance. For example, incidental personal use is okay, but commercial or political use is not. Violating these requirements can result in serious consequences, so read the policy and know the rules.

Information Security Awareness Training

National Cybersecurity Awareness Month is a good time to remind all NAU employees (including student employees) of NAU's information security awareness training requirement. Visit the ITS information security [website](#) to access the online training module and to view the policy.

Personal Safety Devices

In response to an Arizona Board of Regents directive, NAU has updated its [Weapons](#) policy. Certain products are now classified as allowable "Personal Safety Devices." These include personal alarms that emit a loud sound when triggered and defensive pepper sprays. Electroshock devices such as stun guns and Tasers have NOT been approved for possession or use on University property.

Duty to Report Weapons on Campus

All NAU community members share a duty to immediately report the presence or suspected presence of any weapon on campus, such as a firearm, large knife, or other device designed to cause physical injury. Notify a supervisor or contact the NAU police department to make a report.

University Printing Services

To promote economic efficiency and cost-recovery, the new [Printing Services](#) policy requires that all units use NAU's internal print shop for all print jobs in excess of routine photocopying and desktop printing. Visit the University Printing Services [website](#) for more information or to place an order. Departmental expenditures will be monitored to promote compliance with this requirement.
