

Level 1: How to create and sustain successful Indigenous language immersion programs

In this 4-day hands-on, how-to workshop, Dr. Michael Fillerup guides you through a 10-step process for creating a new language immersion program or re-energizing an existing immersion program by converting weaknesses into strengths.

Level 2: How to design an Indigenous knowledge-focused curriculum

In this 2-day workshop, language advocate Jennie DeGroat demonstrates how to collaborate with teachers, parents, administrators, and tribal leaders to develop a language immersion curriculum derived from the knowledge, culture, and values of the community. Participants focus on both curriculum process and product. This is the follow-up workshop to "How to create and sustain successful Indigenous language immersion programs."
