Are our graduates working in their fields of study? 2014-2015 outcomes

SCHOOL COUNSELING DATA 90% of recent grads working as Professional School Counselors

During August 2015, we reached out to all 29 students who had graduated from our School Counseling Masters degree programs between May 2014 and August 2015 from our NAU-Phoenix, NAU-Tucson and NAU-Flagstaff campuses and discovered that 26 of 29 (90%) had obtained full-time employment as Certified Guidance Counselors. The vast majority are working in Arizona, with some in other states, and another at an international school in Germany. Two of those 29 were working as teachers, with one's students situation unknown.

CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING DATA 81% of recent graduates working as Psychotherapists

During August 2015, we also reached out to all 17 students who had graduated from our Clinical Mental Health Counseling Masters degree programs between May 2014 and August 2015 from our NAU-Phoenix, NAU-Tucson and NAU-Flagstaff campuses. We found that 14 of 17 (82%) had obtained full-time employment as psychotherapists in a wide variety of clinical settings – and were on their way toward licensure. Two were still looking, and another was not looking for employment (retired shortly after graduation).
