The Applied Human Behavior (AHB) 90/30 program is ideal for those seeking careers in various helping professions. This includes fields like mental health care, community development, and human resources.

Our Program is Designed to Serve YOU

- **NAU is the only university in Arizona with 90/30 bachelor's degree programs, allowing you to maximize your time and money while pursuing your degree.** Transfer up to 90 lower-division college credits to NAU and complete the remaining 30 upper-division credits (10 courses) to finish your degree without relocating
- **Transfer 2NAU Program**
 - Affordable – Pay community college tuition rates while earning credits toward your NAU degree.
 - Involved – Access NAU resources, guidance, and mentoring.
 - Seamless – Enjoy a smooth transition to NAU when you have completed your community college courses.
 - Scholarship – Receive a merit-based 2NAU scholarship.
 - Get your transcripts evaluated in an expedited evaluation period to know what credits will transfer in and a possible 2NAU application fee waiver after you connect with your NAU Transfer Specialist
- **Access2Excellence (breaking down financial barriers)** - NAU is guaranteeing tuition coverage for undergraduate Arizona residents who have a household income of up to \$65,000. This is applicable at NAU's Flagstaff and Statewide campuses (Online students are not eligible). In addition, members of one of Arizona's 22 federally recognized tribes will receive the full benefit of A2E, regardless of income or state of residency. Learn more at nau.edu/a2e
- **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship** - The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship is for members of the Community College PTK Honor Society who are transferring to NAU. This is stackable with the 2NAU scholarship.
- **NAU Jacks Path (transfer credit tool)** – This tool is designed to show students how their community college courses will transfer to NAU which provides a full picture of their progress towards degree completion. Students are encouraged to use this tool when planning their current community college courses to maximize their transfer credit and align with their intended NAU degree program. - **NAU 2023-2024 Tuition - regardless of location: \$11,352 per year (not including fees ranging \$474 up to \$1300)** We're transparent about the cost of an NAU education because when you know the price of your program, you can find a pathway to attain your future.
