- 2. Click on Apply For a Card tab
- 3. Click on Online Application You will be redirected to the Arizona Applicant Processing Services
- 4. Click on REGISTER apply for a background check
- 5. Click on Apply for a fingerprint Clearance Card
- 6. Click on New Application
- 7. Level 1/Regular Application Click on Health Science Students & Clinical Assistants ARS 15-1881
- 8. Proceed to Application
- 9. Fill out application with all required information
- 10. Leave blank Employer and Employer Address and Click Submit
- 11. You MUST use a Fingerprint Site location listed on the website. Click on website for a list of authorized digital fingerprint sites. Pick your preferred location and schedule an appointment to have your fingerprints taken.
- 12. Contact authorization location to set up an appointment.

Out-of-State Students:

- 2. Click on Apply For a Card tab
- 3. Click on Paper Application & Read all instructions
- 4. Fill out the application with all required information
- 5. Leave blank Name of Employer and Employer Address
- 6. Click on Fee is \$65 if volunteer or where fee is noted as **\$65
- Select Health Science Student & Clinical Assistant ARS 15-1881 \$65
- 8. Print & Hand Sign copy
- 9. Contact your local law enforcement to get fingerprinted
