## About the Concurrent Enrollment Program

Northern Arizona University is proud to have created the first Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP) in the state and one of the first ever in the nation, in 2011. With more than 1,000 BSN CEP graduates, NAU is a proven leader in BSN completion course delivery. NAU started CEP and we have determined what it takes to help students be confident and successful.

## Program Information and Requirements

NAU CEP offers a 90/30 credit split, this means that you can transfer in 90 credits and you will need to complete just 30 credits at NAU to meet the BSN requirements. NAU is the only CEP partner that will accept 90 community college transfer credits. All NAU classes are completed online with the exception of 1 course that will have an optional in-person meeting during the first semester of the program.

This program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).

### Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for participation in the CEP, the following is required:

- Attend a MCC CEP nursing information session.  
Please contact your MCC nursing advisor for questions.
- Complete the prerequisites and be accepted to Mohave Nursing program
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 in all prerequisites that are noted with one asterisk (\*).

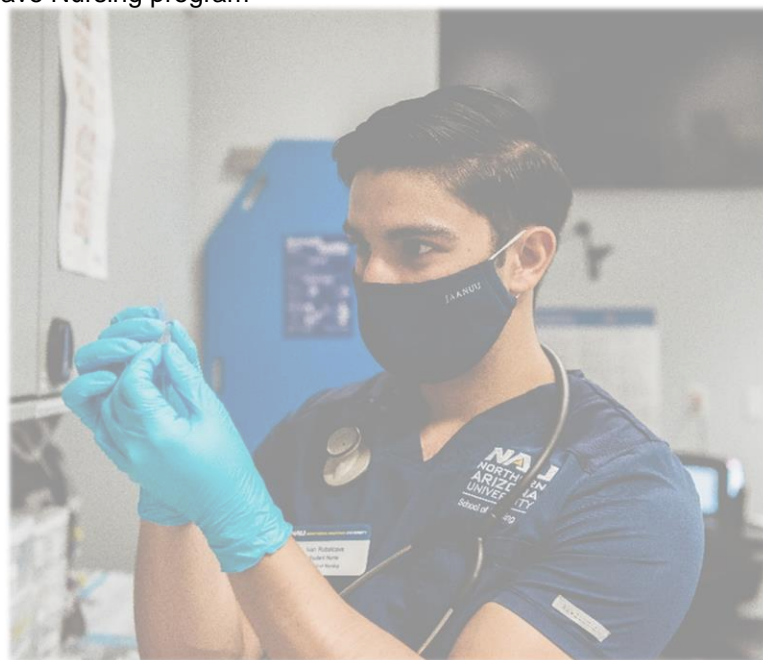

- CIS 110 – Intro to Computers (AAS requirements)
- COM 121 – Interpersonal Communication (AAS requirements)
- Liberal Studies credits **or** AGECE (AAS requirements are included) **or** Posted baccalaureate degree

You may apply to the NAU CEP with up to 7 credits of NAU prerequisites still in progress. Those prerequisites must show as in-progress on your transcript and they must be successfully completed prior to starting your NAU coursework.

\*\*Note: Pathophysiology requirement may be completed online through Rio Salado (HCR 240) or NAU (BIO 320).



## Steps to Success

- ✓ Register for and attend a Mohave Nursing information session.
- ✓ Seek advisement about course requirements and transcript evaluation from your community college advisor.
- ✓ Seek advisement through NAU about CEP and scholarship requirements.
- ✓ Complete MCC prerequisites and apply to the nursing program.
- ✓ Finish NAU prerequisites and confirm your acceptance with NAU.
- ✓ Upon CEP acceptance, you will need to accept your placement by completing the steps outlined in your acceptance email.
- ✓ Attend the mandatory NAU Orientation Session.
- ✓ Successfully complete all MCC ADN and NAU BSN classes.
- ✓ ADN and BSN awarded and you will be eligible to take the NCLEX-RN

## Health and Safety Requirements

MCC and NAU School of Nursing have health and safety requirements that must be met prior to enrolling and participating in clinical experiences. Healthcare agencies throughout the state have vaccinations, titers, and other health-related requirements. Examples of these requirements are background checks, CPR, and drug/nicotine testing. These requirements are subject to change per healthcare agency contracts with the educational institution, and students must be compliant with agency requirements prior to and throughout the program.

## Tuition and Fees

The total NAU cost is approximately \$15,000 for 2021-2022 academic year. Books may be an additional \$1,000.

**Scholarship Opportunities:** Students who are applying to the CEP may qualify for the 2NAU Scholarship. Sign up to participate in 2NAU as early as possible to qualify for the 2NAU Scholarship and receive maximum benefits of this college pathway program. With the 2NAU Scholarship, tuition can be reduced to approximately \$11,000.

Or you may qualify for the Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Scholarship, which is up to \$2,000 per semester for four part-time semesters. This scholarship can reduce the tuition to about \$8,283.

Scholarship awards can be combined. Please meet with your NAU representative to discuss ways to maximize your scholarship opportunities.

\*Tuition rates are based on the 2020-2021 academic year. Costs vary based on part-time or full-time schedules, and number of semesters to complete degree. Scholarship awards are contingent on meeting eligibility criteria. Scholarship and tuition rates are subject to change
