



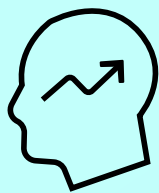

SELECT

Enrollment Guidelines

SELECT is a federally funded program sponsored by the Arizona Department of Education and offered by Northern Arizona University. SELECT courses are recommended for special and general education teachers, administrators, related service personnel, para-educators and NAU students interested in learning more about students with disabilities.

SELECT courses are taught online, at the graduate level, and require a weekly time commitment.
SELECT courses can be taken in two ways:



Professional Growth Verified by a Certificate of Contact Hours

School personnel in the State of Arizona may complete SELECT classes for continuing education credit.

Enrollment materials for professional growth must be received TWO WEEKS prior to the first day of class.

Earned Hours:

Expect to receive a certificate noting professional growth hours approximately two weeks following the last date of class; an official NAU transcript will not be available.

Contact hours awarded depend on your earned grade and completion of the course:

A Grade = 45 hours; B Grade = 30 hours; C Grade = 15 hours; not completing the course or earning a grade below C = 0 hours

Once Enrolled: How to Get Started

Log in to BBLearn through the NAU website during the first week of class to begin work; non-active students the first week will be administratively dropped.
