

Hazardous Material Transport - Propane

Per NFPA 58 –“Liquefied Petroleum Gas Code – 2001, section 6.2 “Transportation of Portable Containers”; cylinders that contain less than 420 lbs. of LP-Gas may be legally transported in university vehicles under the following circumstances:

1. Containers must be DOT approved LP-Gas cylinders.
2. Containers must be placed in a cargo space separate from the driver’s compartment.
3. Containers must be properly secured during transport to minimize the possibility of movement, tipping, and physical damage.
4. Screw-on-type protecting caps or collars shall be secured in place.
5. Transporters must be NAU employees and familiar with this standard operating procedure.
